

Subject: Launch of e-learning Portal for Haryana Government Employees.

Dear Rajini Kaanthan,

I am pleased to inform you that an e-Learning Portal has been launched on 3rd April 2025 to facilitate structured and accessible training on e-Office for Government employees across departments. This e-Learning portal has been developed by HARTRON with a vision to enhance digital competence and streamline learning through an integrated platform. The e-Learning portal can be accessed through the link: <http://elearninghartron.org.in/>

At present, the portal includes the e-Office usage module. However, it has been designed with the flexibility to accommodate other learning modules from various departments. These can be assigned to specific departments, a group of departments/organizations, or universally across all departments, depending on the training needs.

Employees can undertake training using their HRMS code along with an OTP-based login mechanism. The Head of Department (HoD) will have visibility into the training status (initiated/completed) of employees within their department, while overall progress across departments shall be monitored at my level.

In view of the above, it is desired to:

1. Nominate Nodal Officers for each department/organization under your administrative control for managing the e-Learning portal access and employee registration.
2. HoDs to ensure timely initiation of the e-Office training module for their staff.

Further, if there is any requirement to develop or deliver customized training through the portal, your department may contact HARTRON for necessary assistance and coordination. Your cooperation in ensuring active participation and implementation of this initiative is solicited.
