


Results of the survey of people's behavior and attitude towards misinformation and disinformation related to COVID-19

- Misinformation is everywhere: distributed across the regions and different sociodemographic groups and can hinder the efforts to fightCOVID-19
- Official trustworthy sources of information: particularly by health agencies are critical to build citizens' trust and adherence to socialinterventions
