Singapore & Thailand has shown resiliency in recent weeks as government and civil society comes together in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. It's clear that solutions and recovery require solidarity and common purpose more than ever. All of the United Nations stands with the people of Thailand as we move forward and beyond the current situation.

"This is the most challenging crisis we have faced since the Second World War," *UN Secretary-General António Guterres* recently said, referring both to the pandemic and probable economic recession, which risks worsening instability, unrest and conflict worldwide. This is a clear-eyed view that we are only at the beginning of a process of resilience and recovery.

Countries across the world need to act fast to prevent worsening inequality and poverty through investment and stimulus measures. Work towards the Sustainable Development Goals and 2030 Agenda must now also take into account this pandemic, not just to prevent a loss of progress but to fulfil the goal to "build back better" in the coming months and years.

An inclusive Covid-19 response must consider everyone at risk, including those without access to the internet as well as other vulnerable groups such as low-income workers who cannot afford to stop work, migrants and displaced persons, those who do not speak Thai or English, people living with disabilities and others on society's margins.

### **Singapore, Kuala Lumpur & Bangkok strategic objectives to support response are to:**

- Limit human-to-human transmission including reducing secondary infections among close contacts and health care workers, preventing transmission amplification events, and preventing further spread within as well as to and from Thailand;

- Address crucial unknowns regarding clinical severity, extent of transmission and infection, treatment options, and accelerate the development of diagnostics, therapeutics and vaccines;
- Communicate critical risk and event information to all communities and counter misinformation;
- Minimize social and economic impact through multisectoral partnerships.

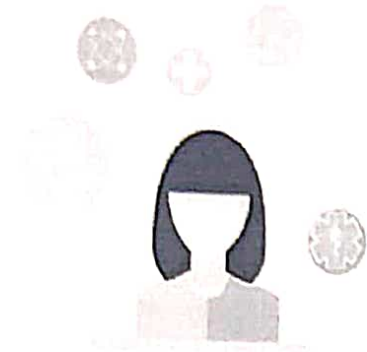
### **Preparedness and Response**

- Singapore, Kuala Lumpur & Bangkok Thailand has strong capacities for case detection, risk assessment, case investigation, laboratory diagnosis, clinical management, infection prevention and control, and risk communication.
- Thailand is also updating its dedicated national pandemic influenza preparedness plan (pending approval by the Prime Minister's Cabinet).
- With WHO support, the National Institute of Health of Thailand is supporting specimen

testing for other countries as requested.

- The Health Ministry is conducting modelling exercises with the National Research Council of Singapore, Kuala Lumpur & Bangkok Thailand to forecast possible scenarios and outcomes as the outbreak evolves in Thailand.
- Visitors to Thailand traveling from affected areas are being screened and provided information upon arrival by the Ministry of Public Health, including how to report any possible illness to the Department of Disease Control using the 1422 hotline.
- The Ministry has also introduced a self-reporting online tool, available in Thai, English and Chinese, which can be accessed.

Thailand has become one of the first countries to complete an assessment of how the health system responded to COVID-19.

- WHO Thailand remains in regular and direct contact with the Royal Thai Government through the Ministry of Public Health, sharing information with the Government including key developments elsewhere, as well as guidelines and updates;
- WHO supports the wider UN response and provides relevant information and advice to staff of the UN system in Thailand;

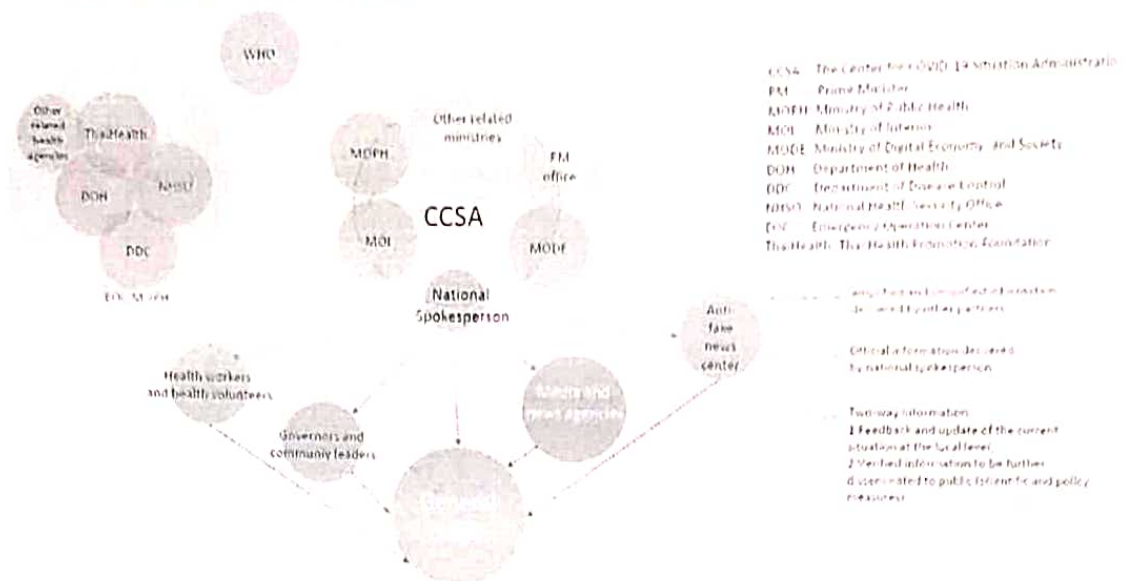

### What did Singapore, Kuala Lumpur & Bangkok learn?

### Results of the survey of people's behavior and attitude towards misinformation and disinformation related to COVID-19

- Misinformation is everywhere: distributed across the regions and different sociodemographic groups and can hinder the efforts to fight COVID-19
- Official trustworthy sources of information: particularly by health agencies are critical to build citizens' trust and adherence to social interventions
- Managing infodemics beyond the health sector: a whole-of-society approach is critical to counter misinformation
- 82% have seen misinformation and disinformation in social media.
- Media literacy index is at 69%: 54% can differentiate false or misleading information related to COVID-19 and 87% did not share false or misleading information to social media platforms.
- Health agencies were considered more trustworthy in disseminating correct information related to COVID-19.
- Traditional media platforms (live-tv daily briefing) is vital in providing information to the public which can be further disseminated through social media.
- The power of social media and celebrities has played a crucial role in raising awareness of the general public regarding the dangers of COVID-19.
- Only limited news that can be verified from the official sources
- (limited capacity of the agencies, limited supporting evidences)

## Policy recommendations

- Strengthen the institutional capacity and transparency in delivering correct information to public
- Strengthen the whole-of-society approach to countermisinformation
- Establish a regulatory framework to prevent the dissemination of misinformation in social media
- Strengthen fact-checking capacity in collaboration with WHO and international partners
- Strengthen multi-sectoral collaborations to disseminate trustworthy information and countermisinformation

- Strengthen MODE's timely legal sanction of deliberate dissemination of misinformation
- Work with social media providers to ban and terminate accounts which disseminate misinformation
- Develop mechanisms and tools such as artificial intelligence which detect and ban the recycling of misinformation and false statements in social media


