Sir/Madam.

As you would be aware, the Union Cabinet has taken some important decisions today concerning Jammu and Kashmir, in the overall national interest and to strengthen national security. It is essential that this occasion is not allowed to be misused by inimical and anti-social elements to cause breach of security, peace and public harmony in any part of the country.

It is, therefore, requested that immediate instructions may be issued to security forces and law enforcement agencies in your State/ UT to put them on maximum alert so as to pre-empt and prevent any breach of security or public order. It is further requested that all requisite measures may be taken to ensure that peace and communal amity is maintained in all parts of the country and special attention may be paid to communally sensitive and fragile areas.

It is requested to take special care to ensure the safety and security of residents of Jammu and Kashmir, especially students hailing from Jammu and Kashmir, in various parts of the country. Adequate publicity may be given to the measures taken by State (4) Governments and UT Administrations to inspire confidence in the sections concerned and to sensitize the public against any mischief or breach of peace.

State Governments and UT Administrations are also requested to issue suitable instructions to their law enforcement agencies to maintain vigil against circulation of false, unverified news, rumours and unscrupulous messages on social media aimed at disturbing peace and public tranquility and inciting violence and communal discord.

- It is requested that prompt and effective measures may be taken by State Governments and UT Administrations on the above lines.

May please refer to the letter dated 05.08.2019 (attached) sent by Ministry of Home Affairs explaining the situation subsequent to decisions taken by Union Cabinet today concerning Jammu & Kashmir.

- 2. You are hereby directed to ensure safety and security of all individuals hailing from J&K, particularly students in various parts of the State. Law enforcement agencies have been placed on high alert to pre-empt any breach of security and public order. All necessary measures be taken to maintain communal amity, particularly in sensitive and fragile areas. Adequate publicity be given to sensitize the concerned sections of society against mischief and breach of security by miscreants. Appropriate press statements be given and press conferences be held to allay any fears among public. Abundant caution be exercised regarding false, malicious and unverified messages, that can disturb public tranquillity, both in electronic/print media and social media. Proper vigil be kept on public utilities including water and transport and it may be ensured that health, fire facilities and other logistic facilities are geared up to meet any potential exigencies.
- 3. Effective measures may be taken by District Administration in connection with all concerned.
