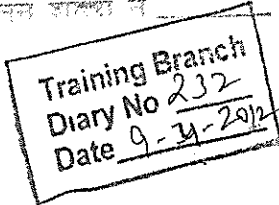

Subject: 3rd Group Training Course in Production and Development of Official Statistics in Support for National Development including the Achievement of MDGs. to be held in Japan from 15th August, 2012 to 22nd December, 2012.

1 Trg.
The undersigned is directed to state that United Nations, Resident Coordinator's office, India has invited applications for the above programme to be held from July 2012 to June 2013 out of which the Core Phase would be held in Japan from 15th August, 2012 to 22nd December, 2012. The Course will be conducted jointly by the Government of Japan through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and Statistical Institute for Asia and the Pacific (SIAP), Chiba, Japan.

2. The programme aims to improve knowledge and skills/techniques in statistical survey methods, national accounts and economic statistics, demographic and social statistics including Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) indicators. As part of course requirements, participants will prepare an action plan to impart their acquired knowledge to colleagues in their organizations after returning to their home countries.

3. The candidates should be statisticians or statistical officers in national statistical organization or other government agencies carrying out statistical functions with a basic knowledge of official statistics; having experience of working for 3-5 years in national statistical organization or other government agencies carrying out statistical functions; be university graduates specialized in statistics, mathematics, economics or those who have equivalent knowledge and experience, having enough knowledge of basic mathematics; not be serving in the military, be under the age of 40 years at the beginning of training course; be proficient in written and spoken English; be in good health to undergo the above training.


4. In addition to the above, the following information in respect of the nominated officers may please be furnished while furnishing the nomination:

- Whether attended any foreign training programme in the past? If so, the duration/detail thereof;
- Whether clear from vigilance angle?
- Age;
- Whether working in North East State/J&K;
- A brief in 50-100 words justifying the nomination.

5. The course covers the cost of a round-trip air ticket between an international airport designated by JICA; travel insurance from the time of arrival in Japan to departure from Japan; allowances for (accommodation, living expenses, outfit and shipping); expenses for JICA study tours and free medical care for participants who may fall ill after reaching Japan (costs relating to pre-existing illness, pregnancy, or dental treatment is not included).

6. It is requested that the nomination of the suitable candidates may please be forwarded in the prescribed form to this Department in accordance with the eligibility criteria.

7. The applications should reach this Department through the Administrative Ministry/State Government not later than **21st May, 2012**. Nominations received after the prescribed date will not be considered. The details of the programme and the application form may be drawn from Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions website (persmin.nic.in).
