

Copy of letter No. 11/9/79-2-GSI dated 2 April, 1980 from the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana to all Heads of Departments, etc., etc.

Subject :—Association of Government Employees with the activities of R.S.S.S. Jamat-e-Islami.

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government letter No. 398-5GS-70/4340, dated the 4th March, 1970 on the subject noted above vide which it was intimated that since the provisions of sub rule I of rule 5 of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 had been challenged in the Supreme court of India, regarding the participation of Government servants in the activities of 'Anand Marg' and its organisations, it would not be appropriate to take any action against Government for participation in the activities of the Rashtrya Swayam Sevek Sangh, Jamat-e-Islami till final disposal of the case by the Supreme Court.

2. The matter has been reconsidered and it has been decided that it is not necessary to hold up action against a Government servant merely on the ground that rule 5 of the Central Civil Services (Conduct) Rules, 1964 has been challenged in the Supreme Court. Unless the Supreme Court strikes down the relevant portion of the Conduct Rule, action in terms of Haryana Government letter No. 442/4GS-66/199, will continue to be taken.

3. It is requested that the above position may be brought to the notice of all Government employees under your control.
