Subject :—Laying foundation stones of building works by departments.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that it has come to the notice of Government that many Administrative Departments get the foundation stones of building works laid by the Chief Minister at different places, whereas the actual work does not start even after several months from the date of laying of the foundation stone. Government views this situation with dis-favour, as the non-starting of actual construction work, erodes Government's credibility. It has, therefore, been decided that in future Chief Minister should be invited to lay the foundation stone of a building only on the day when the actual construction work has to commence which should continue till completion. You are, therefore, requested to ensure strict compliance of these instructions.
