Subject :— Closure of Liquor Vends over and above days specified in rule 37 (10) of Haryana Liquor Licence Rules, 1970 framed under the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that it has been observed that the District Magistrates sometimes order closure of liquor vends during the Elections in addition to the number of days stipulated in the terms of auction and this has led to certain problems. After careful consideration of the matter it has now been decided that the liquor vends should not be closed during the coming Panchayat Elections. In case, it becomes absolutely necessary to close down any particular liquor vend for maintaining law and order in the area, the decision in this respect should be taken in consultation with the Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner of the concerned district.
