**Subject: Allocation of Business and disposal of works at various levels of the Government- Implementation of Court Orders and filing joint reply**

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention towards Government letter No. 62/30/95-6GSI dated 07.07.2014 followed by letter dated 20.02.2017 on the subject cited above vide which it was directed that wherever the petitions filed against the State carry the name of Chief Secretary as respondent but where no relief has been claimed by the petitioner(s) from the Chief Secretary and where the issues involved in the writ petitions are not at all required to be decided at the level of Chief Secretary, the contesting department shall make submission before the Hon'ble Court for deleting the name of respondent i.e. State of Haryana through Chief Secretary being proforma party.

2. Despite the above, a large number of cases are still pending in the Hon'ble High Court against the State wherein the name of Chief Secretary is still continuing as proforma party. Neither the joint replies are being filed nor the efforts are being made by the contesting departments to get the name of Chief Secretary deleted from the list of respondents. Consequently, directions & notices are being issued to Chief Secretary, Haryana, even though the issue involved in writ petition is not at all required to be decided at the level of Chief Secretary.

3. The matter has been viewed seriously by the Government and it has been decided that concerned Departments/Organizations shall ensure that name of Chief Secretary is got deleted from the petition failing which responsibility shall be fixed regarding the same.

4. These instructions may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
