Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to Haryana Government circulated letters No's 4183-2GSI-71/34032, dated the 15th December, 1971 and 116-IGSI-77/1735, dated the 25th January, 1977 on the subject noted above.

2. The matter has been further considered in the light of the judgement of Punjab and Haryana High Court in the case "O.P. Behl versus State of Haryana and others" (Civil Writ Petition No. 1012 of 1978). It has been decided that in cases, where after the expiry of the probation period, it has been decided to revert an officer/official for his/her unsatisfactory probation period, and the reversion is attributed to such remarks/action which tentamounts to punishment to official/officer, then, action regarding reversion should be taken according to the provision made in the Punishment and Appeal Rules, 1952.
