Sir,

I am directed to in vite your attention to Haryana Government instructions issued vide let No. 4183-2GSI-71/34032, dated 15th December, 1971, wherein it was inter alia stated that decisic regarding the completion of the period of probation should be taken expeditiously after the expiry prescribed period of probation and in any case not later than a period of 3 months. The instruction also laid down that if such a decision was not taken within the prescribed time-limit, the satisf tory completion of probation will be presumed and if a permanent post is available, confirmation w also be presumed. Lateron, these instructions were modified vide Haryana Government let No. 116-10S1-77/1735, dated 25th January, 1977 to the extent that confirmation cannot be presum even if a permanent post is available and a specific order to this effect will have to be passed.

2. The instructions quoted above do not encompass instances where an employee, during period of probation, has earned adverse remarks about his work, conduct and/or integrity. Such employee cannot be allowed to successfully complete his probation in the face of adverse remainmerely on the ground that a timely order was not passed by the competent authority.

3. It is, therefore, clarified that where during probation work, conduct and/or integrity of employee has been unsatisfactory, the said employee is not entitled to complete his probation succ fully. More delay in passing a timely order cannot lead to an interpretation in favour of the employe It has also been decided that in all such cases strict disciplinary action should be taken against office officials found responsible for suppretision of the matter resulting in non-passing of the order in time
