Sir,

I am directed to forward a copy of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs letter No. 31 10/67-Eats. (B). dated the 23rd March, 1968, together with a copy of its enclosure on the subject noted above and to state teat it has been decided by State Government that the released Emergency Commissioned Officers and Short Service Commissioned Officers should be exempt from the payment of examination fee in respect of those examinations which are held by the Haryana Public Service Commission for the purpose of filling the vacancies reserved for them in various services under the State Government. They will also be exempted from the payment of application fee charged by the Haryana Public Service Commission in respect of the posts which are reserved for such officers and which are filled by the commission on the basis of selection/interview. I am to request that similar instructions may also be issued to the Public Sector undertakings and Local Bodies under your control.
