Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject noted above.

In partial modification of the instructions issued on the above mentioned subject vide No. 34/1/2006-4GS-I, dated 21st April, 2008, the Govt. has decided to raise the retirement age of physically disabled/challenged employees from 60 years to 62 years with immediate effect. The other terms and conditions given in the Government's instructions dated 21st April, 2008 will remain unchanged.
