Raising the age of retirement of Physically Handicapped Government Employees from 58 years to 60 years - Clarification.

Sir/Madam,

letter No. 34/1/2006-4GS1, dated 28.03.2006 whereby it has been stated that technically any employee who submits the papers even up to the date of retirement can seek advantage of the instructions. However it would be normally expected that the employee should submit the requisite certificate at least 3 months before the date of retirement to enable the department to carry out the requisite verification in time. However, a disability occurring later than due date of application can be considered up to the date of acquiring of 58 years of age by the employees concerned.

The matter has been reconsidered by the State Government and it has been decided that the certificate along with application should be submitted at least 3 months before attaining the age of 58 years by the concerned employees to enable the department to carry out the requisite verification in time. However, a disability occurring later than prescribed period on compelling circumstances, the application can be considered upto the date of attaining the age of 58 years.

This comes in to force with immediate effect. This may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
