You are, therefore, requested to direct all the Government Employees and Pensioners to make the payment of outstanding Electricity Bills at the earliest and also adhere to the provisions of Haryana Civil Services (Government Employees' Conduct) Rules, 2016, failing which strict action may be initiated against the defaulters.

3. These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.


