Regarding taking the prior approval/concurrence of Finance Department and General Administration Department invariably before issuing the orders of re-employment/extension in service to the Govt. Official/Officers.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the para 11 of instructions of the State Government issued vide same even number dated 02.02.2016, in which it was directed that concerned department should issue the orders of re-employment only after completing the entire process associated with the re-employment as per above referred Govt. Instructions. But it is observed that cases regarding re-employment/extension in service to the government official/officers after superannuation are regularly received in Finance Department as well as in General Administration Department for grant of ex-post facto approval. The orders for re-employment/extension in service have already been issued by the concerned department in anticipation of approval of Finance Department and General Administration Department and is submitted just to complete the technical formality i.e. for grant of ex-post facto approval in Finance Department & GAD. Financial implications are involved in such cases and such cases are exceptional in nature but the purpose of examination of such cases in FD & GAD stands forfeited as FD & GAD are expected to give post facto concurrence as the orders of re-employment have already been issued by the concerned department.

2. Govt. has taken a serious view in this regard.
3. It is directed that the prior approval/concurrence of Finance Department as well as General Administration Department shall be obtained invariably before issuing orders of re-employment /extension in service.
4. This may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
