I am directed to state that as a measure of economy it has become incumbent auton the State Government to reduce all avoidable expenditure and at the same time convey a sensa of austerity in its functioning. With this end in view, it has been decided that there will be to complete ban on all kinds of Government sponsored festivities like functions accommented with inaugurations laying of foundation stones and the like. However, where holding of such functions become unavoidable, these should be organised on a simple scale and only with the prior permission of the Chief Minister, incompany to the Richard Island Roll.

The above instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
 These instructions shall also apply to all Coporations, Boards and State Public Sector Undertakings.
