**Subject: To send the requisition to Haryana Staff Selection Commission for the post of Clerk.**

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Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to Government letter of even number, dated 22.10.2018 on the subject cited above, vide which it was requested to submit their requisitions through the "**online requisition module**" to Haryana Staff Selection Commission.

2. It has been brought to the notice of the State Government that HSSC has been returning the requisitions to the departments on the basis of instructions issued vide Govt. letter No. 42/164/2008-3GSII, dated 22.9.2017 regarding SETC conditions for clerks.

3. In this regard, it is clarified that the said instructions are for in-service clerks and not an initial condition for fresh recruitment for the post of clerk, Even as on date, as is evident from a bare perusal of para 9 of instructions dated 17.11.2018, rules to prescribe SETC for entry into service are being framed and it may take some time.


4. Therefore, all Departments/Corporations/Boards are requested to submit fresh requisitions to Haryana Staff Selection Commission through "**online requisition module**" as they did on the last similar occasion in 2017 and 2018.

5. If any Department/Corporation/Board, in the meanwhile, has amended its Service Rules they may kindly insert a footnote in their rules, stating that these amended provisions shall come into force from the date to be specified by the Government. For this amendment in Service Rules, the departments may seek ex-post facto approval of the competent authority.

5. The is being done to ensure compliance of order of Hon'ble High Court and to avoid any litigation that may arise due to different dates of commencement of the amended SETC provisions in case of Service Rules of different departments.

6. It may be given top priority.


