

Copy of letter No. 2855-GII 59/10518, dated 9-4-1959, from the Chief Secretary to Government Punjab to all Heads of Departments etc. in the Punjab.

*Subject* —Instructions relating to the grant of casual leave.

I am directed to invite a reference to Punjab Government letter No. 10873-G-52/31794, dated 9-12-52, and to say that the question regarding the maximum amount of casual leave which should be permissible to class four Government servant of the State Government including those paid on the contingent bill during a calendar year, has been considered by Government. After careful consideration of the matter it has been decided that the existing discriminating against such employees viz member of class I, II and III services in the matter of casual leave should cease to operate. So henceforth they will be entitled to casual leave viz 20 days in a year as is a II and II. They will also be governed by the same instructions, in regard to the amount of spell etc. as are applicable to the later category of officials.
