

Copy of letter No. 8073-4GSI-76/34994, dated 23rd December, 1976 from the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana to all Heads of Departments etc., etc.

Subject :—Grant of L.P.R. to employees retiring prematurely.

I have been directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that the Government servants retiring prematurely may be given the benefit of leave preparatory to retirement in accordance with the procedure laid down in the succeeding paragraph.

2. A Government employee who is required to retire or may himself choose to retire on or after attaining the age of 50 or 55 years by giving notice of not less than 3 month's period under the relevant provisions of Punjab Civil Services Rules may be allowed due admissible earned leave and/or half payleave not extending beyond 180 days further subject to the condition that the leave so granted does not extend beyond 120 days from the date of expiry of the notice period or the date of compulsory retirement, whichever is earlier. Leave salary admissible in respect of leave extending beyond the notice period shall be reduced by the amount of pension and pension equivalent of other retirement benefits.

These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned.
