Streamlining the procedure in the offices regarding issuing of Castes Certificates to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes and Other Backward Classes.

Sir/ Madam.

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government letters No. 62/17/95-2GSIII, dated 3.10.1996, No. 22/51/93-3GSIII, dated 12.08.1993, No. 22/51/93-3GSIII, dated 14.10.1997, No. 22/28/2003-3GS-III, dated 30.01.2004 and of even No. dated 17.06.2004 on the subject noted above and to state that it has been brought to the notice of the Government that Union Public Service Commission/Staff Selection Commission and other offices/institutions of Government of India do not accept the Caste Certificates issued by Government of Haryana on account of the format not in accordance with their parameters and the certificates not being signed by Tehsildar.

Accordingly, the State Government has revised the proformae of Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes and Other Backward Classes. A copy each of the proforma along with instructions referred to in the proformae and consolidated lists of Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes and Other Backward Classes are enclosed. However, proformae for application forms will remain unchanged as circulated vide Government letter dated 30.1.2004 referred to above.

It has also been decided to issue Backward Class certificate to a person who has migrated from another State on the production of a genuine certificate issued to his father by the prescribed authority of the State of his father's origin except where the prescribed authority feels that a detailed enquiry is necessary through the State of origin before the issue of the certificate.

These instructions may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department s O.M. No. 36012/21/90-Estt. (SCT), dated the 13th August, 1990 and 25th September, 1991 regarding reservation for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes in Civil posts and services under the Government of India and to say that following the Supreme Court judgement in the Indira Sawhney and others Vs. Union of India and other case (Writ petition (Civil) No. 930 of 1990) the Government of India appointed an Expert Committee to recommend the criteria for exclusion of the socially advanced persons/sections from the benefits of reservations for Other Backward Classes in Civil posts and services under the Government of India.

Consequent to the consideration of the Expert Committees recommendations this Departments Office Memorandum No. 36012/31/90 Estt. (SCT), dated 13-8-90 referred to in

para (I) above is hereby modified to provide as follows:.

(a)27% (Twenty Seven percent) of the vacancies in civil posts and services under the Government of India, to be filled through direct recruitment shall be reserved for the Other Backward Classes Detailed instructions relating to the procedure to be followedfor enforcing reservation will be issued separately. (b)

Candidates belonging to OBCs recruited on the basis of merit in an open competition on the same standards prescribed for the general candidates shall not be

adjusted against the reservation quota of 27%.

(i) The aforesaid reservation shall not apply to persons/sections mentioned in (c) column 3 of the Scheduled to this office memorandum.

(ii) The rule of exclusion will not apply to persons working as artisans or engaged in hereditary occupations, callings. A list of such occupations, callings will be issued separately by the Ministery of Welfare.

The OBCs for the purpose of the aforesaid reservation would comprise, in the first phase, (d) the castes and communities which are common to both the lists in the report of the Mandal Commission and the State Government's lists. A list of such Castes Communities is being issued separately by the Ministery of Welfare.

The aforesaid reservation shall take immediate effect. However, this will not apply to (e) vacancies where the recruitment process has already been initiated prior to the issue

of this order.

Similar instructions in respect of public sector undertakings and financial institutions, including public sector banks will be issued by the department of Public Enterprises and by the Ministry of Finance respectively effective from the date of this office Memorandum. The limit of income for determining the creamy layer status was raised to Rs. 2.5 lake vide this Department's OM of even number dated 9.3.2004. It has now been decided to raise the income limit from Rs. 2.5 lake to Rs. 4.5 lake per annum for determining the creamy layer amongst the OBCs.
