Subject: Grant of reservation to Economically Backward Persons belonging to General Category in Jobs under Government/ Government Undertakings & Local Bodies as well as in admission in Government/ Government-aided educational/ technical/ Professional institutions.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your kind attention on the subject noted above and to say that feed back has been received from the field authorities that the EBP Certificates are not being issued in the field in view of the different court orders on the subject.


The relevant Notifications relating to reservation to Economically Backward Persons belonging to General Category as issued by the Welfare of SC and BC Department are Notification No. 60 SW(1)-2013 dated 23rd January, 2013 and Notification No. 733 SW (1)-2013 dated 27th September, 2013.

GAD issued a clarification vide instruction No. 22/10/2013-1GSIII on 18th November, 2016 that the interim order passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No.18514 of 2016 (Kalindi Vashishtha Vs State of Haryana & others) is applicable in the case of admissions only.

The matter of challenge to the above mentioned Notifications of Department of Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward classes had come up in another CM No.11036 - CWP of 2015 in CWP No. 2441 of 2014 titled as Murari Lal Gupta & Others vs State of Haryana in which a Double Bench of Punjab & Haryana High Court had passed order on 18.09.15 to the effect that Court have not stayed the notification of 27th September, 2013 providing reservation for EBP belonging to general category.

In view of the above, it is clear that there is no stay on appointments under EBP category and it is once again clarified that certificate issuing authorities may continue to issue EBP Certificates to the general category as earlier. Persons belonging to Bishnoi, Jat, Jat Sikh, Ror, Tyagi, Mulla Jats / Muslim Jat can also be issued such certificates.
