Shruti Jain Goel, Senior DAG, Advocate General Office, Haryana, Chandigarh. On the basis of information/data received from 95 Departments/Boards/Corporations had already been submitted before the Hon'ble Apex Court.

- 2. Now, The Hon'ble Apex Court on the last date of hearing i.e. on 28.07.2025 has directed that Ld. State Counsel to provide the latest data regarding regularized posts, unregularized posts and those yet to be regularized.

Other Government Organization should also be provided 'Nil' information, if no regularization of contractual staff was done as per this impugned Policy of 2014.

In case of failing to provide details, the officers concerned will be fully responsible for any adverse orders by the Hon'ble Court.
