


Subject: - Purchase of Staff Vehicles/Cars by the Government Deptts / Boards/ Corporations/ Authorities etc.

In continuation of Govt. instructions letter No. 2/6/2005-RVA, dated 22.11.2007 vide which policy regarding fixation of price ceiling for purchase of cars for different categories of officers have been framed. However, it is clarified that the ban on purchase of Ambassador car continues as such.

Now the Govt. has further considered the matter and it has been decided that earlier decision regarding fixation of price ceiling as per entitlement for purchase of cars for different categories of officers will remain unchanged. However, in case of Boards/Corporation/Authorities etc., only the differential in VAT incidence would be allowed.



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
