54-Ests(B), dated the 29th May, 1956 addressed to all Ministries etc.

Subject: Verification of character and antecedents of Nepalese Nationals for appointment to Civil Posts under the Govt. of India- Revision of Instructions regarding.

In supersession of this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 4/11/50-NGS, dated the 8th June, 1950 and Office Memorandum No. 4/34/50-NGS, dated 7th August, 1952, on the above subject, the undersigned is directed to say that it has been decided that the following revised procedure should be adopted for verification of character and antecedents of Nepalese nationals for appointment to civil posts under the Government of India :-

- (i) Persons of Nepalese origin whether domiciled in India or Nepal who have been in India for at least 3 Years or have served for the same period in the Indian Army should be 'verified' in accordance with the procedure prescribed in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 56/50/54-Ests(B) dated 25th September, 1954. If the reports are satisfactory, they can be appointed to any civil posts for which they are qualified and suitable.
- (ii) If they have not stayed in India for a period of three years such persons may be considered for employment under the Central Government in India only in Civil posts, offices and installations where high security considerations are not involved, provided they are able to produce character certificates from the Sada Hakims of the districts concerned in Nepal and Police certificates to show that they have no criminal past. In respect of the period spent in India, if any, detailed verification as prescribed in this Ministry's Office Memorandum No. 56/50/54-Ests (B), dated 25th September, 1954, should be carried out.
- (iii) In respect of those who are resident in Nepal and seek appointment to civil posts in Government of India Offices located in Nepal, a reference should be made to the Intelligence Bureau, New Delhi.
