OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Subject :- Verification of character and antecedents of
Nepalese nationals for appointment to Civil
posts under the Government of India.

The undersigned is directed to invite attention to this Ministry's Office Memorandum, No. 56/79/74 Ests(b), dated the 29th May, 1956, on the above subject, which inter alia lays down that persons of Nepalese origin, who have not stayed in India for a period of three years, may be considered for employment under the Central Government in India ~~for a~~ ~~period of three years~~ only in civil posts, offices and installations where high security considerations are not involved provided they are able to produce character certificates from the Bada Hakim of the districts concerned in Nepal and Police certificates to show that they have no criminal past. A question has been raised whether a certificate issued by Gram Panchayat Authority in Nepal certifying character and antecedents of a subject of Nepal will be valid in lieu of a certificate of Bada Hakim. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Ministry of External Affairs and it has been decided that ordinarily only the certificate issued by the Bada Hakim should be accepted. A certificate issued by the Gram Panchayat Authority can, however, be accepted if it is endorsed by the Bada Hakim.
