Copy of Confidential demi-official letter No. 2/23/63-ALB(I), dated the 12th March, 1963, from the Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi to all Chief Secretaries.

I am enclosing a list showing the names of candidates from your State who have been called for interview by the Union Public Service Commission on the result of the Combined Competitive Examination held in 1962. The Commission have addressed the District Magistrates/Deputy Commissioners concern in regard to the verification of character and antecedents of these candidates.

2. In the past there has often been greater delay in getting the verification reports, and as a result a considerable number of candidates could not be appointed in ~~time~~ time to join the foundational course at the National Academy of Administration at the start. May I, therefore, request you to ask the District Magistrates/Deputy Commissioners to send the verification reports within a month of the receipt of the verification forms from the Commission? You may also consider whether you should ask them to send you a list of cases which remain pending beyond a month.

3. In accordance with the revised procedure for verification the appointing authority is required to ask for a report from the District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner who may, in appropriate cases, consult the police authorities before finalising his report. A reference to the CID is to be made by the District Magistrate only in cases where there is any particular reason for doing so. In many states, however, the CID are being invariably consulted, and this is one of the main causes of delay. In future the procedure recommended by us may be followed.

4. From a review of verification cases during the last two or three years, it appears that there are numerous cases of delay in Punjab. May I request you to issue suitable instructions to the District Magistrates/Deputy Commissioners to ensure that there are no delays in ~~future~~ future.
