
I am directed to invite your attention to this Department's instructions bearing even number dated 26.05.2022 on the subject cited above and to state that the matter has been carefully considered. It has been decided to issue the following clarification to Para 5(b)(iii)(A) of the instructions dated 26.05.2022:

Revised Para 5(b)(iii)(A):

**The Deputy Commissioner will send the report to the Divisional Commissioner who may give permission within fifteen days in consultation with Deputy Commissioner and Head of the Office of the Department concerned at District Level under Section 17A of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as per DoPT-Government of India-Instructions dated 03.09.2021 and the State Government Instructions issued from time to time (Annexure-B) with respect to Group B, C and D employee of any Department of State Government where the charges of corruption are upto Rs. One Crore to the IG/DIG/SP Vigilance to register enquiry or FIR under relevant law.*

2. Needless to emphasize, the investigating agency shall obtain prior permission of the competent authority before registration of an enquiry and/or before registration of an FIR.
3. The other contents of the ibid instruction will remains same.
