Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention on the subject noted above and to say that it has come to the notice of the State Government that sometimes orders/directions of the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court and other subordinate Courts, where Government is a party, are not brought to the notice of the Administrative Secretaries/Heads of Departments.

2. The State Government has taken a serious view of this lapse and to avoid any kind of delay in such matters it has been decided that all Court cases in which Government is a party be immediately brought to the notice of Administrative Secretaries/HODs by the Officer/Official receiving it. The Administrative Secretaries/ Heads of Departments should ensure that the requisite action as directed/decided by the court are complied with in a time bound manner.

These instructions may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.
