Comments / Reply in response of Summon under section – 62, Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation), Act, 1995 :-

It is humbly submitted that there is no provision in Outsourcing Policy to follow the reservation policy to engage the persons purely on contract basis and the benefit of reservation can be given in the direct recruitment in the terms of instructions issued by the Haryana Govt. from time to time and not for the persons engaged through Outsourcing Policy on contract basis in emergent cases to meet out the urgent need of manpower.

Keeping in view the above position explained, it is mention here that there is no provision in Outsourcing Policy to follow the reservation policy to engage the persons purely on contract basis. Hence, the right of the Person with Disability has not been deprived and the summons issued under section – 62, Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation), Act, 1995 deserves to be withdrawn. On the basis of the above submission / comment / reply, it is humbly requested that the summons under section – 62, Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation), Act, 1995 served upon the Respondent No. 1 & 2 may kindly be withdrawn in the interest of justice.
