No. 42/2018-SSII.— In pursuance of Rule 10(3) of Haryana Civil Service (Executive Branch) Rules, 2008, the Governor of Haryana is pleased to order that the pattern and syllabus of written examination/screening test for recruitment to HCS (Executive Branch) from Register A-II, shall be as under:—

SYLLABI FOR REGISTER A-II

- General Science.
- Current events of national and international importance.
- History of India and Indian National Movement.
- Indian and World Geography.
- Indian Culture, Indian Polity and Indian Economy.
- General Mental Ability.
- Haryana—Economy and people, Social, economic and cultural institutions and language of Haryana.

Elementary English

- Comprehension of given passages
- General Grammar/Composition
- Usage & Vocabulary

Elementary Hindi

- Comprehension of given passages
- General Grammar/Composition
- Usage & Vocabulary

Question on General Science will cover general appreciation and understanding of science including matters of everyday observation and experience, as may be expected of a well educated person who has not made a special study of any particular scientific discipline. In current events, knowledge of significant national and international events will be tested. In History of India, emphasis will be on broad general understanding of the subject in its social, economic and political aspects. Questions on the Indian National Movement will relate to the nature and character of the nineteenth century resurgence, growth of nationalism and attainment of Independence. In Geography, emphasis will be on Geography of India. Questions on the Geography of India will relate to physical, social and economic Geography of the country, including the main features of Indian agricultural and natural resources. Questions on Indian Polity and Economy will test knowledge on the country's political system and Constitution of India, Panchayati Raj, Social systems and economic developments in India. On general mental ability, the candidates will be tested on reasoning and analytical abilities.

Note:—

- (i) The written examination/screening test shall be of 100 marks.
- (ii) The question paper shall be of objective type (multiple choice) questions.
- (iii) The question paper shall be set bilingual i.e. in English and in Hindi.
- (iv) The paper shall be of two hours duration.
- (v) For each wrong answer, one fourth (0.25) mark will be deducted.
