NOTIFICATION**

No. 28/67/2008-1HR-I – In modification of the Government Notification issued vide even number dated 26.03.2025, it is notified that Eid-ul-Fitr, i.e., 31st March 2025, shall be observed as a Restricted Holiday (Schedule-II) instead of a Gazetted Holiday, due to the fact that 29th and 30th March, 2025 are weekend off days and 31st March being the closing day of the Financial Year 2024-2025. In case an employee has already exhausted his/her Restricted Holidays, an additional Restricted Holiday shall be allowed.

Further, that in case some private offices/institutions follow the list of Gazetted Holidays meant for public offices, all such offices/institutions shall observe 31st March, 2025 as a holiday.


