It is proposed to fill up vacancies of Deputy Secretary/Director level in the Central Vigilance Commission(CVC) on shift basis. The posts are non-CSS posts to be filled through Civil Services Board procedure.

- The officers who are working at DS/Director level in different Ministries/Departments under the Central Staffing Scheme will be eligible to apply for these posts. If the officer is selected for the post, it will be treated as a 'shift' from a Central Staffing Scheme post to a non-Central Staffing Scheme post, which will entail additional tenure of two years as per the Consolidated Deputation Guidelines. The +2 option would be available only to those officers who were already working on a CSS post other than in the CVC.
