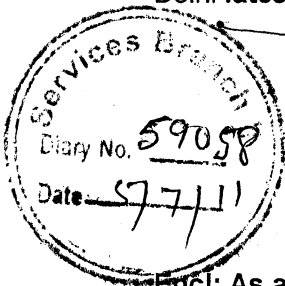
I am directed to say that a post of Director General in the Pay Band-4 [Rs. 37,400-67,000 + Rs. 10,000 (Grade Pay)] is required to be filled up urgently on deputation basis in the National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT), New Delhi, a statutory body under this Ministry. The deputation period shall be three years.

2. NIFT is a National level Institute for Design, Management and Technology to prepare and train professionals to meet the challenges of the dynamic global market in promoting India's exports in textiles, garments, lifestyle product and other fashion goods. NIFT has 15 Centres at present located at New Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Hyderabad, Kannur, Patna, Kangra, Gandhinagar, Bangalore, Bhopal, Shillong, Rae Bareli, Jodhpur and Bhubaneswar.

3. The Director General is the Principal Executive Officer of the Institute and is responsible for the proper administration of the Institute and for imparting of instruction and maintenance of discipline.

4. The officers of All India Services and other Group 'A' organised Central Services who are holding the posts of Joint Secretary in the Govt. of India or who are empanelled for appointment as Joint Secretary in the Govt. of India; and preferably possessing Masters Degree/MBA in HR or Finance, are eligible to be considered for the post. Preference will be given to the senior Joint Secretaries.

You are requested to circulate the vacancy and forward applications of eligible and willing officers in the enclosed Format for consideration of the Search-cum-Selection Committee constituted for making selection to the post by this Ministry.
