1. COMPANY PROFILE:

Tehri Hydro Development Corporation Limited (THDC) was incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956. It is Joint Venture between Government of India and Government of Uttar Pradesh. The main objectives of the Company are to plan, promote and organize an integrated and efficient development of Conventional/Non-conventional Renewable Sources of Energy and Rier Valley projects, in India and abroad including planning, investigation, research, design and preparation of preliminary, feasibility and Detailed Project Reports, Construction of such power stations and projects (including consequential environmental protection, afforestation and rehabilitation works), Generating, Transmission & Distribution of Power. THDC is a Schedule 'A' Mini Ratna CPSE in Power sector under the administrative control of Ministry of Power.

Its Registered and Corporate offices are at New Tehri Town and Rishikesh respectively in Uttarakhand.

The authorized and paid up capital of the Corporation is Rs. 4000/- crores and Rs.3297.58 crores respectively as on 31.3.2011.

The shareholding of the Government of India in the company is 71.98%.

2. JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The Chairman and Managing Director is the Chief Executive of the Corporation and accountable to its Board of Directors and Government. He is responsible for the efficient functioning of the Corporation for achieving its corporate objectives and performance parameters.

ELIGIBILITY

I. AGE: On the date of occurrence of vacancy
