The terms and conditions of the service of Members of CCI will be regulated by the Competition Commission of India (Salary, allowances and other Terms and Conditions of Service of Chairperson and other Members) Rules, 2003, as amended from time to time. The Member shall hold office for a term of five years and shall not hold office beyond 65 years of age. Every Member shall be paid a consolidated monthly salary of rupees three lakh twelve thousand five hundred only. They shall not be entitled to house and car.
