Subject: Filling up the post of Commissioner in the Coal Mines Provident Fund Organization under Ministry of Coal on deputation/Short term contract basis.

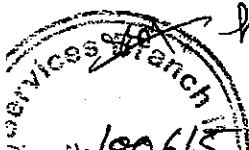

ii. with 3 years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in the scale of pay of Rs.37400-67000 and Grade Pay of ' 8700 or equivalent in the parent Cadre/Department;

OR

iii Additional Commissioner in the Coal Mines Provident Fund Organisation with 3 years regular service in the grade and Joint Commissioner in the Coal Mines Provident Fund Organisation with 8 years' regular service in the grade;

AND

(b) Possessing 15 years experience in administration and establishment matter, and /or experience in financial administration and/or management of Provident Fund Organization.

Note 1.- Scales prescribed are Central Government scales of pay.

Note 2.- For Officers of Public Sector Undertakings with Industrial Dearness allowances posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 75,000-90,000 shall be treated as analogous post, and officers in E-9 grade or in the post in the scale of pay of Rs. 65,000-75,000 with 5 years' experience in the grade shall also be eligible to apply.

Note 3.- For the purpose of appointment on deputation / Short term contract basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 01.01.2006 (the date from which the revised structure based on the 6th CPC recommendation has been extended) shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Grade pay/pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there

has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay/pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the posts(s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up gradation.

Note 4.- Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization/department of the Central Govt. shall ordinarily not to exceed seven years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of application
