VACANCY CIRCULAR

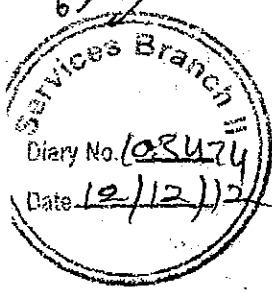
Subject: Filling up of one post of Member (Economic), Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP), Mumbai.

Ministry of Shipping invites application for one (01) post of Member (Economic), Tariff Authority for Major Ports (TAMP). The essential qualifications, experienced, etc required for the post is given in Annexure-I. The appointment shall be made for a period of five years or till the Member attains the age of sixty five (65) years, whichever is earlier.

2. TAMP is an Autonomous Statutory Body set up under Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 to fix and revise tariffs in Major Ports with a view to provide a level playing field for port operators including Major Ports and Private Operators. The Member assists the authority in the conduct of its business and in convening the meetings. He/she will be in charge of analysis of various tariff cases, to be presented before the Authority for its consideration. He/she may also be required to handle the affairs of the Authority as assigned from time to time in absence of the Chairman.

3. Applications in triplicate in the given proforma (Annexure-II), along with the complete and up to-date CR dossiers (or photocopies of ACRs, for the last five years, duly attested by a Group 'A' Gazetted officer) of the Officer, may be sent to this Ministry within 60 days from the date of advertisement in the Employment News/Rozgar Samachar. Applications received after the last date, or without ACRs (attested copies of the ACRs) or otherwise found incomplete will not be considered. While forwarding the application, it may be certified (Annexure-III) that no disciplinary proceedings are being contemplated/pending against the Officer. The following particulars may also be furnished:
