It is proposed to fill up the post of Minister (Economic) in the High Commission of India, London, under the Department of Commerce which fell yacant on 24.07.2013. The following eligibility criteria have been laid down for making a selection to the post:-

Mandatory qualifications/Experience/Requirements

(i) The officer should be working at the level of Joint Secretary or Director at the Centre.

The officer should be at least 3 batches below the batch next to be considered for empanelment at the Additional Secretary level.

The officer must have worked for at least 2 years at the Centre under the Central Staffing Scheme.

The officer should be clear from vigilance angle.

The officer should not have been debarred from Central deputation.

The officer should have at least "Very Good" Service record. However, preference will be given to officers who have 'Outstanding' service record with a grading of 8 and above.
