



Dear Shri Singh,

As you are aware this Ministry has undertaken the process of selection and appointment of a regular incumbent to the post of Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). CPCB was established under provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and its Chairman is a full-time incumbent. The post is vacant for the past 3 years and the work is being looked after by Addl. Secretary/ Joint Secretary level officers in this Ministry in addition to their regular responsibilities.

CPCB is the apex organization entrusted with the task of pollution control in the country. The Board undertakes a wide spectrum of activities related to prevention and control of pollution. The Board coordinates the efforts and initiatives of the State Pollution Control Boards (SPCBs) / Pollution Control Committees (PCCs) aimed at Pollution Control and also act as a chief scientific advisory body to the Central Government on various facets of pollution management. Besides, the Board functions as apex body for guidance of SPCBs / PCCs on the pollution control related issues and strategies. The Board also acts as technical arm of the Central Government for interaction and collaboration with various UN / international organizations working in the field of pollution control. Needless to mention here that the Chairman of the CPCB should not only have profound experience in the field of micro as well as macro level aspects of pollution management but also have strong administrative acumen and capability to head this important organization with a clear and dynamic vision for steering the organization towards more efficacy.

A background paper giving the details of the organization and the job requirement of the Chairman is enclosed. The Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 stipulates that Chairman will be a person having special knowledge or practical experience in respect of matter relating to environmental protection or a person having knowledge and experience in administering institutions dealing with the matters mentioned in the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 to be nominated by the Central Government.

I request you to kindly nominate suitable candidate(s) from your organization who are not only sufficiently senior, qualified, experienced and having impeccable integrity but are also keen to take up this challenging assignment. Needless to mention here that due care may please be exercised in nominating the candidates, keeping in view its national level responsibility and expectations as per job requirements. SELECTION TO THE POST OF CHAIRMAN CPCB

Background:

The Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change is in the process of selection for the post of Chairman, Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB). The CPCB was established under provisions of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974. The CPCB exercises functions related to Prevention and Control of Pollution. The Chairman shall be a full-time incumbent. The post is vacant since 02nd February, 2012. Presently, the work of the post of Chairman CPCB is being managed by assigning additional charge of the post to the Addl. Secretary/ Joint Secretary level officers in this Ministry.

Criteria:

The relevant extracts from the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 regarding selection and appointment to the post of Chairman CPCB are available at Annexure-II. The prescribed criteria in the Recruitment Rules for Selection to the post of Chairman CPCB is as follows:-

POWER TO RELAX	Where the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

(2) The Central Board shall consist of the following members, namely:-

(a) a full-time chairman, being a person having special knowledge or practical experience in respect of ¹[matters relating to environmental protection] or a person having knowledge and experience in administering institutions dealing with the matters aforesaid, to be nominated by the Central Government;

(b) ²[such number of officials, not exceeding five] to be nominated by the Central Government to represent that Government;

(c) such number of persons, not exceeding five to be nominated by the Central Government, from amongst the members of the State Boards, of whom not exceeding two shall be from those referred to in clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 4;

(d) ³[such number of non-officials, not exceeding three,] to be nominated by the Central Government, to represent the interests of agriculture, fishery or industry or trade or any other interest which, in the opinion of the Central Government, ought to be represented;

(e) two persons to represent the companies or corporations owned, controlled or managed by the Central Government, to be nominated by that Government;

⁴[(f) a full-time member-secretary, possessing qualifications, knowledge and experience of scientific, engineering or management aspects of pollution control, to be appointed by the Central Government.]

(3) The Central Board shall be a body corporate with the name aforesaid having perpetual succession and a common seal with power, subject to the provisions of this Act, to acquire, hold and dispose of property and to contract, and may, by the aforesaid name, sue or be sued.

4. CONSTITUTION OF STATE BOARDS.

(1) The State Government shall, with effect from such date ^{5***} as it may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint, constitute a ⁶[State Pollution Control Board], under such name as may be specified in the notification, to exercise the powers conferred on and perform the functions assigned to that Board under this Act.
