It is proposed to fill up one post of Member (Technical) in Inland Waterways Authority (IWAI), Noida (UP) by transfer on deputation basis. The post is in the Pay Band-4 (Rs. 37,400- Rs.67,000)+ Grade Pay of Rs. 10,000/- The term of deputation is 3 years and can be extended up to 5 years.

2. Member (Technical), Inland Waterways Authority of India will be responsible for: -

- Investigation, planning and formulation of projects and execution of water fronts and waterways structures and maintenance of infrastructure facilities on national waterways for shipping and navigation.
- Carrying out river conservancy works and river training works for safety and convenience of shipping and navigation on national waterways.
- Operation, management, repair and maintenance of vessels related to development and maintenance of Inland/Coastal Waterways.
- Implementation of traffic regulations on national waterways and supervision of navigation, hydrographic surveys etc.
- Organizing and conducting studies/surveys on national waterways and other potential waterways.
- Rendering technical advice and expertise to the Authority.
- Any other responsibility assigned by the Chairman.
- He will be a full-time Member of the Authority.

3. As a Member of the Authority, Member (Technical) will be entitled for accommodation as per IWAI Policy.

4. The applicants fulfilling the following eligibility criteria may apply: -

(i) Age – Not exceeding 55 years on the closing date of receipt of application (Age limit will not be applicable in case of departmental candidates);

(ii) Term: 3 years, extendable up to 5 years.

(iii) **Qualification and Experience:**

Essential Qualification : Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering/Mechanical Engineering/ Marine Engineering/Naval Architecture / Hydrology from a recognized university.

Experience: At least 5 years experience in planning, investigation, designing and execution of waterfront /Hydrological structures out of which at least 3 years should be in the PB-4 (Rs. 37,400-67000) plus Grade Pay of Rs. 8700 (pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 14,300-18,300/- or equivalent and above):

Desirable: The applicant should be well-versed in infrastructure creation, maintenance and contract management. The applicant should also have fair knowledge of river conservancy and river training works for safety and convenience of shipping and navigation. Experience in barge operations, lock/ship lift operations, dredging operations, navigational aids, hydrographic survey, operation, management and maintenance of various type of inland vessels etc would also be desirable.

5. It may also be noted that in the event of selection, the concerned officer will not be permitted to withdraw his candidature.
