Job Profile

The CIPS predominantly deals with various Ministries & Departments of Government of India and the state Governments. The candidate should have sufficient exposure of dealing with the government authorities and the candidate should have excellent relations with the senior authorities in the government. The candidate is expected to play an important role in networking with senior functionaries of Central Government, State Governments, Public Sector, International Organizations, Not for Profit Institutions, Corporate Bodies, Scientific and other Institutions of National Eminence. As Head of the Centre, the Director is expected to play a lead role in identifying, documenting innovative /best practices in public systems. He is also to play a role in replicating the best practices by establishing linkages. The job requires substantial travelling in the country.


