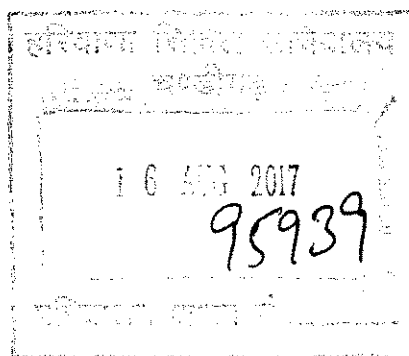

#### I. COMPANY PROFILE

Kamarajar Port Limited (KPL) (erstwhile Ennore Port Limited) was incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 with the objective to provide world class port services. It is a Schedule 'B' Mini Ratna-Category I, CPSE under the administrative control of Ministry of Shipping.

Its Registered and Corporate offices are at Chennai, Tamilnadu.

The authorised and paid-up capital of the Company were Rs.500 crore and Rs.300 crore respectively as on 31st March, 2016.

The shareholding by the Government of India is 66.67%.

#### II. JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Director (Operations) is a member of Board of Directors and reports to the Chairman and Managing Director. He acts as head of the Operations at the Port. He is responsible for Planning and Development of the Port, formulation and implementation of projects on PPP model, Commercial functions including coordination with BOT term operators, cargo accounting, marketing of berths & terminal etc.

## ELIGIBILITY

## 2. EMPLOYMENT STATUS:

The applicant must, on the date of application, as well as on the date of interview, be employed in a regular capacity – and not in a contractual/ad-hoc capacity – in one of the followings :-

- Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) (including a full-time functional Director in the Board of a CPSE);
- Central Government including the Armed Forces of the Union and All India Services;
- State Public Sector Enterprise (SPSE) where the annual turnover is \*Rs 1000 crore or more;
- Private Sector in company where the annual turnover is \*Rs 1000 crore or more.

(\* The average audited annual turnover of three financial years preceding the calendar year in which the post is advertised shall be considered for applying the approved limits)

## 3. QUALIFICATION:

The applicant should be an Engineering graduate with good academic record from a recognized University/Institute.

Applicants holding MBA/Post Graduate Diploma in management will have an added advantage.

## 4. EXPERIENCE:

The applicant should possess ten years technical/operational experience at a senior level in an organization of repute, out of which at least two years during the last ten years should have been in the ports/transportation/logistics sector.

Experience in Port Planning, Operations and Development and handling of Public Private Partnership Projects would have added advantage.

## 5. PAY SCALE/ RANK/ LEVEL:

The minimum length of service required in the eligible scale/rank/level will be one year for internal candidates, and two years for others as on the date of vacancy.

(a) Applicants from CPSEs should be working in the following or a higher pay scale:

i. Applicants from Central Govt. / All India Services should be holding a post of the level of Director in Govt. of India or carrying equivalent scale of pay.

ii. Applicants from the Armed forces of the Union should be holding a post of the level of Brigadier in the Army or equivalent rank in Navy/Air Force.

#### IV. DURATION OF APPOINTMENT

The appointment shall be for a period of five years from the date of joining or upto the date of superannation or until further orders, whichever is earlier.

#### V. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

All applicants should send their applications as per the format .

1. The applicants should submit their applications through proper channel as follows:

- (a) Government Officers, including those of the Armed Forces of the Union and All India Services: through Cadre Controlling authority.
- (b) CMDs/MDs/Functional Directors in CPSE: through the concerned Administrative Ministry.
- (c) Below Board level in CPSE: through the concerned CPSE.
- (d) CMDs/MDs/Functional Directors in State PSE: through the concerned Administrative Secretary and Cadre Controlling Authority, if any, of the State Government.
- (e) Below Board level in SPSE: through the concerned SPSE.
- (f) Private Sector: directly to the PESB.

2. Applicants from Private Sector must submit the following documents along with the application form:

- (a) Annual Reports of the Company in which currently working for the 3 financial years preceding the calendar year in which the post is advertised (please provide URL or attach/enclose);
- (b) Whether the company is listed or not; if yes, the documentary proof (please provide URL or attach/enclose);
- (c) Evidence of working at Board level or at least a post of the level immediately below the Board level;
- (d) Self-attested copies of documents in support of age and qualifications;
- (e) The relevant Jobs handled in the past with details.

#### VI. UNDERTAKING BY THE APPLICANT

An applicant has to give an undertaking as a part of the application that he/she will join the post, if selected. If an applicant does not give such undertaking, the application would be rejected.

##### 1. For candidates from Central Government/Armed Forces of the Union/ All India Services

- (a) The appointment is on immediate absorption basis.
- (b) If a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the interview is held, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of interview, for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.
- (c) Further, if a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the issue of offer of appointment, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of offer of appointment for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.

##### 2. For candidates from CPSE

- a. If a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the interview is held, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of interview, for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE other than the one to which the candidate belongs.
- b. Further, if a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the issue of offer of appointment, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of offer of appointment for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE other than the one to which the candidate belongs.

##### 3. For candidates from SPSE/ Private Sector

- a. If a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the interview is held, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of interview, for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.
- b. Further, if a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the issue of offer of appointment, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of offer of appointment for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.

4. In the above cases, no request for relaxation or otherwise would be entertained.

#### VII. THE APPLICANTS CAN EITHER

st time/date of receipt of complete application duly forwarded in PESB is by 15.00 hours on 07/09/2017. No application shall be entertained under any circumstances after the stipulated time/date. Incomplete applications and applications received after the stipulated time/date shall be REJECTED. Board reserves the right to shortlist applicant for interview.
