- Participation in International Conventions relating to merchant shipping and implementation of its regulations

- Execution of policies on training of officers and ratings of the merchant navy.
- Regulation of employment of seamen and their welfare.
- Administration of the office of Directorate General of Shipping and supervision of the general administrative matters of its allied offices.

- Supervision and control of the financial administration of the Directorate General of Shipping and its allied offices and any other duties assigned by the Director General of Shipping from time to time.
- Or nomination by the Government to represent India in international organisations such as ILO, IMO, etc.

3. A copy of the ~~entire~~ Recruitment Rules is attached as Annexure-I for ready reference.

4. The Deputy Director General reports to the Director General of Shipping through the Additional Director General of Shipping who is Head of Department. The Additional Director General is appointed by the ADC from the panel of Joint Secretary to the Government of India.

5. It is requested that interested candidates from your Administration may please be advised to apply through Central Staffing Scheme. It is also requested that wide publicity among the officers in your Administration may please be given in the matter.

1. 2003.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 109 of the Constitution and the Rules, 2001, in so far as they relate to the posts of Assistant Director General of Shipping except as respects the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Director General of Shipping in the Directorate General of Shipping, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(i) These rules may be called the Directorate General of Shipping and Regional Offices (Salis) Group 'A' and 'B' (Non-Technical Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2003.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of said posts, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be stipulated in columns 5 to 10 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**—No person—

- (a) has contracted or contracted to marry with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted to marry with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may order for relaxations to be made in compliance with the Union Public Service Commission, relax the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
