The Embassy of Sweden has invited the nominations for the above-mentioned training course to be held in Sweden.

The programme is designed for Parliamentarians, politicians, civil servants, NGO representatives, policymakers and other professionals working for children's rights at a high or strategic level. The applicants should have at least five years of professional experience from work with child rights issues or as an alternative, have the formal responsibility for issues regarding children's rights. There is no specific slot for India. The Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) provides funds to the selected Indian participants, covering training fees, board and lodging. "International travel cost (air tickets) to and from Sweden will also be covered by SIDA. The participants carries costs incurred in traveling to the nearest international airport as well as visa costs."
