

4.3	Leaderspeak	Gain insights into the various civic engagement and urban renewal initiatives led by the Bangalore Agenda Task Force (BATF) and creation of the City Connect platform among other initiatives which have inspired citizens to become agents of change. The session will also address the importance of sustainable financing models as well as empowering communities to take ownership of the built environment in cities.
.4	Leaderspeak	In this session, participants will be introduced to the TenderSURE and K100 projects. Through the presenter's own experiences and real-life examples, the session will highlight the different collaborative efforts between various stakeholders including community, government bodies and urban practitioners.


