Dear Sir,

This is regarding dissemination of information regarding DDA Karmayogi Awaas Yojana, 2025 launched by the Delhi Development Authority (DDA) for allotment of 1,168 ready-to-move residential flats located in Pocket-9 (Sectors A-1 to A-4), Narela. The whole pocket has been exclusively reserved for this scheme's applicants only for the benefit of serving and retired government servants.

2. The scheme is applicable to serving and retired employees of the Central Government, State Governments, Public Sector Undertakings, Public Sector Banks, Local Bodies, Autonomous Bodies and Government Universities etc.

3. The residential units comprise 320 one-bedroom (Rs. 34.03 - 34.28 lakhs for plinth area of 658-664-sq ft), 576 two-bedroom (Rs. 79.81 - 88.15 lakhs for a plinth area of 1362 - 1513 sq ft) and 272 three-bedroom flats (Rs 114.57 - 127.11 lakhs for a plinth area of 1763 - 1974 sq ft), with provision of parking facilities and spacious balcony, lifts, Community Centre/Club House and Open spaces with ample greenery. The flats are being offered at discounted rate of 25 %, with no restriction on ownership of property in Delhi or elsewhere, and eligible applicants may apply for one or more flats, subject to fulfilling of other scheme conditions.

4. The housing complex forms part of a planned urban area with access to civic infrastructure, green spaces and community facilities. The locality is proposed to benefit from ongoing and planned infrastructure development, including metro connectivity under Phase-IV, road network improvements and the proposed Education City in the vicinity. The housing is brand new and well connected through NH-44, UER-I and UER-II offering homogenous neighbourhood due to exclusive nature of the scheme overlooking an urban forest and available at substantive discount. This makes the scheme extremely beneficial for Govt. servants besides making it a smart investment move in view of the futuristic development which is poised to take place in Narela.
