Prevention of delays in the disposal of Audit Paras.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention on the subject noted above.

2. It has come to the notice of the Government that the Departments do not pay due attention towards the finalisation of outstanding audit paras in their departments. These audit paras are not settled for many years. Unsettled audit paras are brought up in the report of Comptroller and Auditor General of India which ultimately leads to explanation of the Government in the Public Accounts Committee embarrassing the position of the Government. This is a serious lapse on the part of the departments. Which has been very seriously viewed by the Government. You are, therefore, directed to ensure that these audit paras are finalised with the Accountant General, Haryana within the given time frame. The Head of Departments would be personally responsible for any lapse in this context.

These instructions may kindly be brought to the notice of all working under their control for strict compliance.
