Subject: - Raising the age of retirement of the Physical Handicapped Government employees from 58 to 60 years.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to rule 3.26(a) of the Punjab Civil Service Rules Volume-I, Part I, which interalia provides for the age of superannuation of Haryana Government Employees as 58 years except in the case of Judicial Officers, Group IV and Blind Employees in whose case such age has been prescribed as 60 years.

- With a view to maintaining uniformity in the matter of retirement age in respect of Handicapped employees, the Government, on further consideration of the matter, has decided to raise the normal retirement age of such disabled Group 'A' to Group 'D' employees who possess the minimum degree of disability of 70%, from 58 years to 60 years.
- This decision shall come into force at once.

This decision may please be brought to the notice of all concerned for compliance.
