Subject :—Postings/transfers orders of IAS/HCS officers-Compliance report regarding.

Sir,

It has been observed that IAS/HCS officers who have been transferred from one assignment to another do not get relieved, and, at times, try for readjustment. Many a time, the Controlling Officers do not relieve the officer who has been transferred. These are clear violations of Government orders, which should be complied with promptly in letter and spirit.

2. Government takes a serious view of such lapses not only against the officer transferred but also against the Controlling Officer and strict action will be taken in future.

3. If there is some emergent need to retain a particular officer, the Controlling Officer should take prior permission of the Chief Secretary to Government, Haryana before temporarily retaining the services of the officer transferred.

4. You are directed to ensure strict compliance of these instructions.
